STUDENT MEDIA ADVISING EXPERIENCE

- Advised student newspapers for nine years: Baldwin Wallace University (2017 – present) and Waynesburg University (2010 – 2017)
- Grew the staff size and overall student participation, at Waynesburg University (12 to 26) and at Baldwin Wallace (4 to 32), through targeted recruitment and retention of non-journalism majors by teaching transferrable skills and avoiding ‘silo’ approach where student newspaper is seen only as avenue for those with journalistic vocational aspirations
- Expanded focus beyond weekly paper production to digital storytelling skillsets including web design, social media, design and layout, and video and audio, as well as the fundamentals of writing, reporting, and editing
- Launched both newspapers’ social media efforts and Waynesburg’s website; encouraged students to pursue stories on digital platforms regardless of print publication schedule
- Encouraged students to approach work comprehensively, considering visual presentation, interactive elements, audience engagement, etc., in addition to foundational concepts of editorial judgement and clear and concise writing to most effectively communicate with an audience
- Oversaw staff efforts that produced more than 60 collegiate awards, including 5 national awards
